



New Pediatric Dermatology Residency Track at CHOP & UPenn

The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP) Section of Dermatology and Penn Medicine's Department of Dermatology at the University of Pennsylvania would like to announce a newly combined PGY 1-4 Pediatric Dermatology focused residency track.

This new track includes a PGY 1 pediatric internship year at CHOP, and PGY 2-4 dermatology residency position (with dedicated time to pediatric dermatology training throughout the 3-year dermatology residency, including development of a pediatric dermatology outpatient continuity clinic starting as early as PGY 1 year).

Strong candidates who are committed to a career in pediatric dermatology are encouraged to apply for this unique opportunity, which requires a combined match. The preliminary pediatric year and dermatology residency years will involve a pediatric dermatology continuity clinic throughout. Graduates of the program will be expected to board certify in General Dermatology. We anticipate most graduates will likely plan to subsequently complete a 1-year Pediatric Dermatology fellowship post residency.

Interviews will occur over a 1-day schedule and will include coordinated interviews with both the CHOP Pediatric Residency Directors and Penn Dermatology Faculty.
